

Research and innovation to develop sustainable lifestyles and technologies for Saint-Martin.

A botanical garden preserving rare fruit trees and medicinal plants from the local heritage.

Compact aquaponics enabling the cultivation of plants and fish with minimal water and maximum sustainability.

A community garden for residents of Quartier d'Orléans in need.

A well drilled at the village was made possible thanks to the support of **Rotary Club Saint-Martin Nord** and **EXOFOR**, project partners through philanthropic sponsorship in the public interest.

This project is part of an ecological, social, and solidarity-based approach, grounded in trust, individual responsibility, resource sharing, and active participation by residents.

- Maximum **two plots per family**


